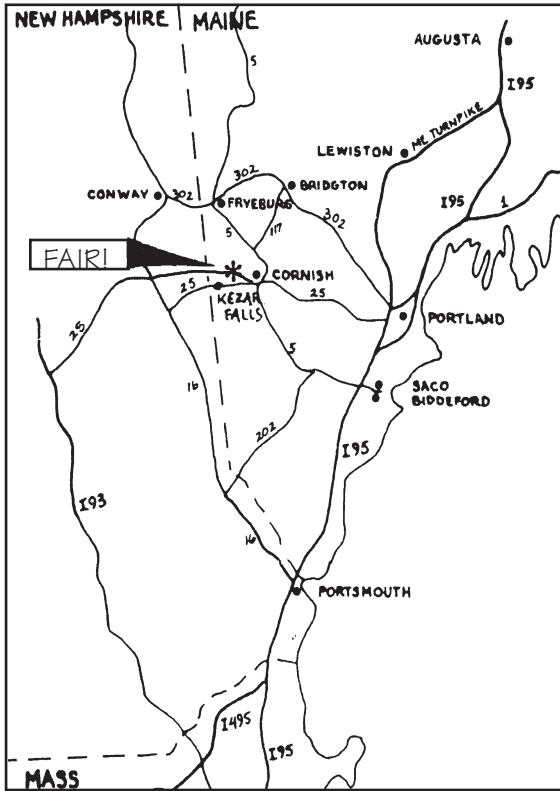

Follow route 25 East to Cornish. Turn left at Moulton Lumber - continue as above.

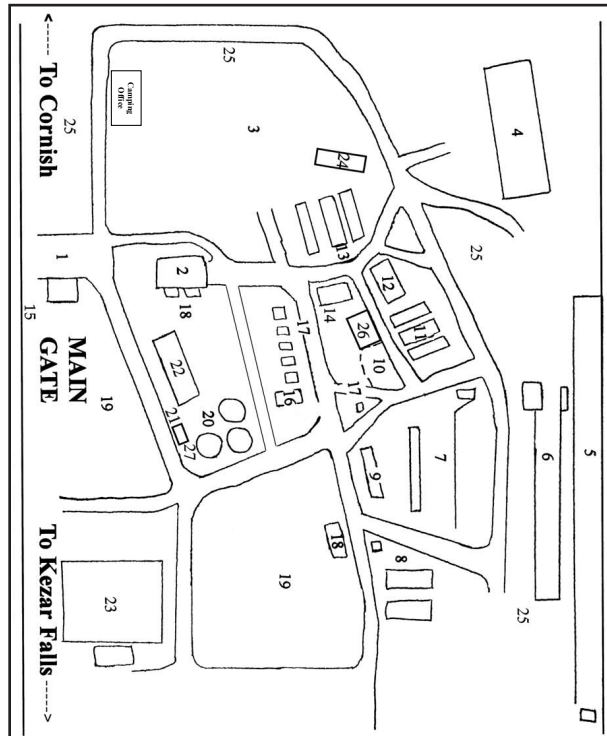
From Bridgton and North Windham:
