**Saturday, July 10,2021 Following 4-H show.**

All exhibitors must show proof of Mine Association of Livestock Exhibitors insurance to be eligible to participate in any sheep shows. Sheep be on fairgrounds by Wednesday p.m.

All animals must be properly tagged, registered in the name of the exhibitor and papers must be available throughout the fair.

Animals will be inspected upon arrival for contagious diseases and parasites. Any animals found to be unhealthy will not be allowed to be penned.

Age of animals will be figured as of September 1<sup>st</sup>.

All sheep must be reasonably fitted to receive a premium.

Not more than 3 breeds may be shown by an exhibitor.

A maximum of 2 premiums will be paid per class per exhibitor.

One farm or family will be considered one exhibitor.

Exhibitors must display farm signs to be considered for any Shepherd's Award (see below).

All entries must be mailed to the superintendent. Entries will be processed on a first-come basis.

Exhibitors must supply their own bedding.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning pens before they will be released.

All sheep will be released no earlier than 6:00 p.m.

### **Shepherd's Award (Open Class)**

Exhibitors must be present for the duration of the fair to receive an award. Farm sign must be displayed. Interaction with the public is encouraged and will be considered. Evaluations will be conducted daily, based on the following:

Quality of educational display posted to or around pens 40%

Neatness of animal pens and tack areas 20%

Cooperation with other exhibitors 20%

Positive interaction with the public 20%
